Today their outreach includes sixteen counties in the tri-state area, Currently, the Food bank of Siouxland provides food to nearly 200 member agencies, consisting of food pantries, emergency relief agencies, shelters, children's homes, day care centers, rehabilitation programs, senior citizen centers and other outreach programs. These agencies are spread across Iowa, Nebraska and South Dakota. Every \$25 provides a meal for 225 hungry children. That means with our \$1000 donation approximately 9000 meals were provided for the needy. That is something to be proud of.
